

HOW TO APPLY GLUE-ON NAILS

It is recommended that Glue-On nails and Glue-On nail products are removed after two weeks.

APPLYING SELF-STICK NAILS

Step 1

Clean and dry nails thoroughly. Moisture will affect adhesion of artificial nail products and can cause fungal and bacterial infections.

Step 2

Select a full set of nails which best fits the width of your natural nails.

Step 3

Position on nail as close to your cuticle as possible (DO NOT PUSH UNDER YOUR CUTICLE) and press down firmly for a few seconds while the glue bonds.

APPLYING GLUE-ON NAILS – for extended wear

Step 1

Clean and dry nails thoroughly. Moisture will affect adhesion of artificial nail products and can cause fungal and bacterial infections.

Step 2

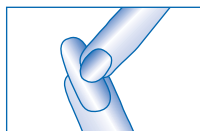
Select a full set of nails which best fits the width of your natural nails.

Step 3

Dot and evenly spread Nail Glue over your natural nail.

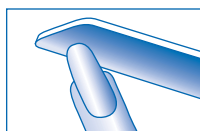
Step 4

Position Glue-On nail as close to your cuticle as possible (DO NOT PUSH UNDER YOUR CUTICLE) and press down firmly from the cuticle down the length of the nail for 30 seconds or until bonded.



Step 5

For unpainted nails - Shape to desired length and paint with your favourite enamel.



APPLYING GLUE-ON NAILS – for one-night wear

Step 1

Clean and dry nails thoroughly. Moisture will affect adhesion of artificial nail products and can cause fungal and bacterial infections.

Step 2

Select a full set of nails which best fits the width of your natural nails.

Step 3

Apply a tab to each of your natural nails. Remove protective backing and apply Nail.

Step 4

To remove, soak nails in warm soapy water for at last 5-10 minutes. Gently lift glue-on nail off using a Cuticle Stick.
