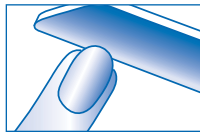


HOW TO APPLY NAIL TIPS

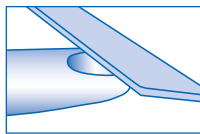
For both Gel and Acrylic application. Always ensure your nails are thoroughly clean and dry before applying artificial nails or artificial nail products. Moisture will affect adhesion of artificial nail products and can cause fungal and bacterial infections.

Step 1 - Preparing Your Nails

1. Protect the working area by covering with paper towel.
2. Remove all nail enamel with Non-acetone Nail Polish Remover.
3. Trim and shape nails evenly.

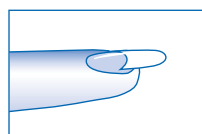


4. Use a cuticle stick to gently push back cuticles.
5. Gently buff shine from natural nail surface. Take care not to buff excessively as this will weaken your natural nail.

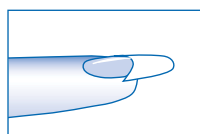


Step 2 - Correct Tip Size

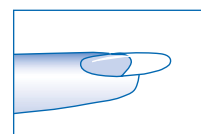
1. Choose an artificial nail tip to fit each nail.
The sides of the tip should be in line with the sides of your natural nail.
If you cannot find the correct size, use a nail file or nail shaper to file the sides of the tip for a perfect fit. To help you select the correct size, numbers under side of each tip can be used as a guide. The suitability will depend on the width of your nail bed.



TOO SMALL



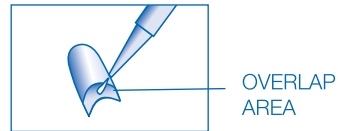
TOO BIG



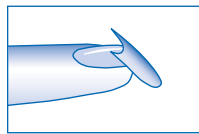
CORRECT SIZE

Step 3 - Applying Tips

1. Apply one drop of Nail Glue to the overlap area of the artificial tip. Spread evenly.



2. Hold the artificial tip at a 45 degree angle. With the overlap area of the tip against the free edge of your natural nail



3. Press the artificial tip down firmly and hold in place until bonded.
Note: It is recommended that you remove the tip and start application again if any air pockets or bubbles are present as they can cause fungal and bacterial infections.
4. Use a buffer to smooth the seam line of the artificial tip.
